LUNCH BOX IDEAS - FRIED RICE SALAD



Ingredients:

1 tablespoon sesame oil
1 onion, finely chopped
1 red capsicum, seeded, finely chopped
1 green capsicum, seeded, finely chopped
2 rashers shortcut rindless bacon, finely chopped
4 cups cooked brown rice
125g can corn kernels, drained
6 green onions (shallots) thinly sliced
1/4 cup light soy sauce
1/4 cup hoisin sauce
Cherry tomatoes, halved

Method:

Step 1:

Heat oil in a large frying pan or Wok over high heat. Saute` onion, capsicum and bacon for 3-4 minutes.

Step 2:


Add rice, corn, green onions and sauces. Stir-fry for 2-3 minutes, mixing well. Transfer to a bowl to cool.

Step 3:

Spoon salad into lunchbox or other sealable container. Top with halved cherry tomatoes and coriander leaves, keep chilled.
