Welcome to Week Three at Seaham Public School. I am currently attending the Principal's Conference in Sydney and being inspired by the many wonderful programs and innovative strategies being rolled out into NSW Public Schools.

**Staff Training:** Staff at Seaham recently have been attending additional training sessions after school involving learning and mandatory training in such things as code of conduct, corruption prevention, PBL, curriculum updates and CPR and Anaphylaxis training. These afternoons replace the two staff development days at the end of the year, meaning teachers and students attend their final day for the year on Friday, December 15, 2017. There will be no teaching staff at school on Monday and Tuesday, 18 and 19 December. The office will be open and some support staff will be in attendance if you have any office based enquires.
