Tell Them From Me

Why we do it - This term, we are asking our community to participate in the Tell Them From Me parent survey. The survey will provide us with valuable feedback on our parent's/ carer's perceptions of their child's experiences at home and at school. Schools in Australia have used the Tell Them From Me survey to help them improve. This survey will help our school better understand how to improve student wellbeing and engagement. It will help the school identify what works to improve student outcomes. Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary.

Confidentiality - The survey is completed on-line and is run by an independent research company, The Learning Bar, which specialises in school-based surveys. Staff in schools will not be able to identify individual parents/carers from their responses.

How to do it - The survey typically takes 15 minutes or less to complete. To ensure confidentiality, participating parents/carers will be able to complete the survey at home by going to http://nsw.tellthemfromme.com/t29cm or use the gr code below.

How to help - Please notify your child(rens) teachers when you have completed the survey online through Dojo or the office. Each family only needs to complete the survey once. The class with the most responses will have a special pizza lunch.

The survey closes on Friday 8th November.



Hydrate with H20

Did you know your body is made up of 50-70% water?

Water is essential in a heathy diet. It helps transport nutrients through our bodies, digest food, remove waste, regulate body temperature, and also keeps our teeth and mouth healthy.

Encourage your child to choose water as a drink by:

- · Packing a water bottle in their school bag everyday

- Serving plain water in a jug. Try adding ice-cubes and fresh fruit pieces such as lemon, orange, blueberries or strawberries for flavour
- Using a re-usable drink bottle that your child has chosen
