#### **SEAHAM PUBLIC SCHOOL - 2025 ATHLETICS CARNIVAL**

The 2025 Athletics Carnival will be held at **Maitland Athletics Centre** on **Tuesday May 13, 2025**. All students K - 6 will be attending. Years 3 - 6 and Year 2 students turning 8 this year can participate in the official PSSA Athletics Carnival. K - 2 will participate in fun activities in a designated section in the middle of the field.

**800m races and K-2 activities will start at 9.30am.** Parents may transport their children to the ground themselves or children may catch a bus from the school. Children will need to assemble as normal under the large COLA and wait for a teacher to escort them to the bus. Cost of the bus is \$10 and students will be invoiced after the carnival.

All teachers will attend the carnival. Normal class supervision will not occur at school.

The K-2 carnival will finish at 12:30 and the primary athletics carnival will conclude at around 2pm. Buses will take K-2 students back to school at 12:30pm and the remainder at around 2pm. Parents can take their children home with them at the conclusion of their carnival. They are asked to notify their child's teacher of their intention to do so.

Students will need:-

- Sports uniform and joggers (House Colours may be worn no singlet tops)
- Suitable sun hat and sunscreen
- Water bottle and recess (there will be no refill stations so extra water may be required)
- Recess and lunch.

## Canteen facilities TBA

Joggers are to be worn – <u>no bare feet</u>. This is a rule of the ground as well as the school. Spikes may be worn in lane events only. <u>Children using spikes must change back into joggers immediately following the race</u>.

Permission and transport options need to be completed via the SENTRAL Parent Portal by Monday May 12, 2025.
